## **Canada Games Flag Raising Ceremony**

As part of the Canada Games alumni, the Canada Games Council has invited Lethbridge to participate in the cross Canada tour of the *official* Canada Games Flag before it is raised at the Opening Ceremonies in Halifax on February 11, 2011. The tour began December 3 in Whitehorse, Yukon the 2007 host community and will arrive in Halifax Nova Scotia on February 10, 2011.

This cross Canada tour serves as a kick off to engage all past Canada Games Host Communities in the celebration of the upcoming Canada Games; the 2011 Canada Winter Games February 11 - 27, 2011 in Halifax Nova Scotia.

The **official** Canada Games flag to be flown at the Opening Ceremonies in Halifax on February 11, 2011 will be with each past Canada Games Host Community for a total of 3 days before being sent to the next community. Lethbridge will have the flag from December 16 – 18, 2010.

"This event brings back a lot of great memories when Lethbridge hosted the 1975 Canada Winter Games," says Gary Bowie, Chair, Lethbridge Sport Council. "Lethbridge has hosted many first-rate sporting events and looks forward to future hosting opportunities.
