



COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

PHASE 2: JULY 1, 2020

Please note that procedures may change at any time as directed by Lethbridge Sport Council, Alberta Government and Alberta Health Services.

Lethbridge Sport Council reserves the right to ask patrons who are not abiding by the listed regulations to leave the program.

COHORTS

- All online registered patrons will be placed into cohorts of 12 or less
- Cohorts will be scheduled to arrive and leave a minimum of ten minutes apart to avoid congestion and to minimize risk of hazards between cohorts

SCREENING

- Declaration of health screening of all individuals entering the play space will be done on-site using a paperless electronic method
- Documentation of the information collected during the screening process will be available for two weeks following each Roving Gyms session for contact tracing purposes

Individuals who express experiencing any of the symptoms of COVID-19 or who have come in contact with anyone experiencing symptoms in their declaration of health document will not have access to the program and should get tested for COVID-19.

CLEANING

- Lethbridge Sport Council will clean and sanitize all equipment with Avmor EP50 Epopure Cleaning Disinfectant – Hydrogen Peroxide Solution used according to the manufacturer's instructions between each Roving Gyms session

DISTANCING

- 2 metre distancing minimum between cohorts
- Food or beverages will not be permitted in the PLAY space

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

- Lethbridge Sport Council will provide hand sanitizer at the entrance and exit for patrons' use
- It is up to each individual whether they choose to wear a face mask during moderate physical activity
