LETHBRIDGE SPORT COUNCIL ACHIEVEMENT AWARD RECIPIENTS

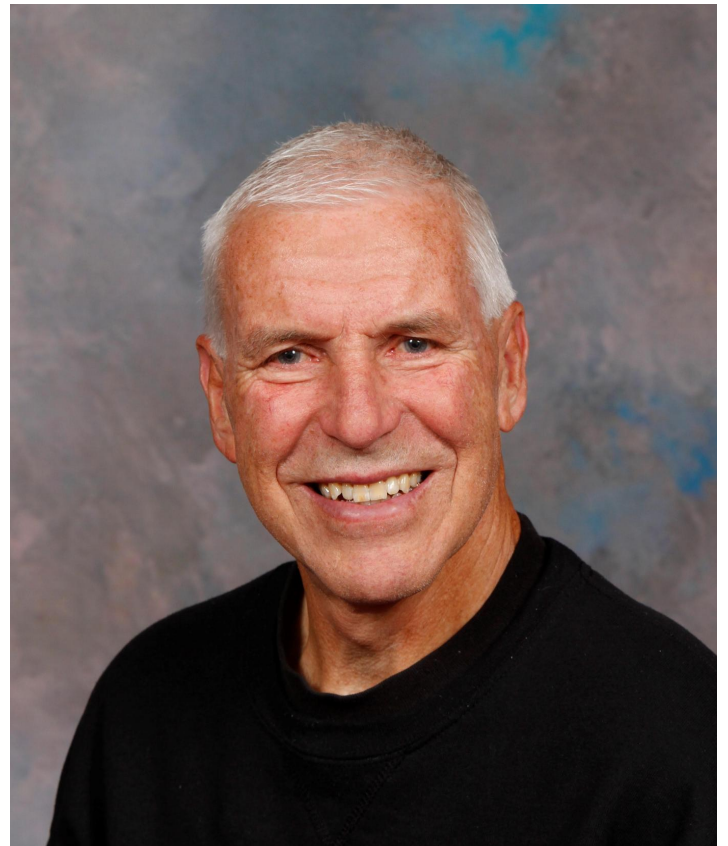
