

Please note that procedures may change at any time as directed by Lethbridge Sport Council and Alberta Health Services.

Lethbridge Sport Council reserves the right to ask patrons who are not abiding by the listed regulations set by Alberta health officials to leave the premises.

BOOKINGS

- All bookings **MUST** be completed online and approved by Lethbridge Sport Council.
- Bookings will be scheduled a minimum of 30-minute apart for cleaning and sanitizing.
- Booking requests may be denied if Lethbridge Sport Council staff is unavailable to clean and sanitize between bookings.

SCREENING

Screening of all individuals entering the room is the responsibility of the booking host. Documentation of the information collected during the screening process must be available for no less than two weeks following your booking for contact tracing purposes.

1. Do you have a fever, sore throat, cough, runny nose, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing (not otherwise explained)?
2. Have you or anyone in your household travelled outside of Canada in the last 14 days and have COVID-19 symptoms?
3. Have you or anyone in your household been in contact in the last 14 days with someone who is being investigated or confirmed to be a case of COVID-19?
4. Are you currently being investigated as a suspect case of COVID-19?
5. Have you tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 10 days?

Individuals who answer yes to any of these questions will not have access to the Lethbridge Sport Council Community Room and should get tested for COVID-19.

CLEANING

- Lethbridge Sport Council will clean and sanitize between each booking.

DISTANCING

- Room capacity is 15 individuals
- Table configuration must accommodate 2-metre physical distancing
- One chair per table
- Food or beverages should not be shared

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

- Lethbridge Sport Council will provide hand sanitizer upon entry for visitor use.
- It is up to each individual whether they choose to wear a face mask
